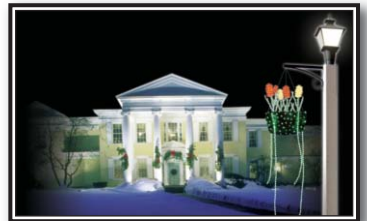
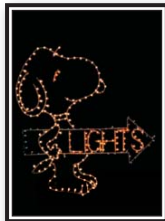

Learn exactly what it takes to make Oglebay's annual Winter Festival of Lights one of America's largest and favorite light shows.

From making sure that the blueprints are delivered on time to the local high school to checking each and every light bulb, Oglebay staff members work very hard every day to make sure that the Christmas light show gets up and running each November. (After all, the lights don't just pop out of the ground and appear on trees and buildings by themselves!) Now is your chance to get a peek with the *Behind-the-Scenes of the Winter Festival of Lights*.

Join an educator for a personalized behind-the-scenes look at the light show. You'll learn how the show got its start in 1985, where the ideas come from each season for new and refreshed displays, how labor intense the show is (from set up to tear down) and other insider tidbits.
