Oglebay Attractions

Oglebay Past and Present Tour

An Oglebay Resort tour guide will step onto your motorcoach and relate some of Oglebay's rich heritage, including stories about the Oglebay family and how the park came to be. **Allow 1 hour.**

Oglebay Institute's Mansion Museum

The museum, once the home of Colonel Oglebay and family, takes visitors on a journey into the past as they enter the treasure house full of antiques and history. **Allow 1 hour.**



Bissonnette Gardens Walking Tour

Covering the hilltop region of Oglebay, the gardens are a re-creation of the gardens that existed when the Oglebay family inhabited the mansion. **Allow 1/2 hour.**

Good Zoo at Oglebay

The zoo sits on 30 acres and has 50 species of animals, many of them rare or endangered. The zoo also features an Australian walk-thru aviary with a lorikeet feeding exhibit, train ride, Discovery Lab, the Benedum Theater and West Virginia's largest working miniature train exhibit. **Allow 2 hours.**

Schrader Environmental Education Center

A unique center constructed using "Green Architecture," featuring fun and educational displays such as the Forest Canopy Walkway and a Butterfly Garden. Plus Bird Cafe and Discovery Trails. **Allow 1 hr.**

Oglebay Institute's Glass Museum

With displays of over 3,000 examples of West Virginia glass made from 1829-1939, the museum features cut lead crystal and Victorian art glass, plus the Sweeney Punch Bowl - the largest piece of cut lead crystal ever made. Participants are able to experience live glassworking demonstrations in the studio.

Behind the Scenes Garden Tour

Available April - October

Enjoy a peaceful, history-filled behind the scenes tour of Bissonnette Gardens. Bissonnette Gardens, once named Waddington Gardens, are a restoration that existed at Oglebay when the property was still a private estate in the early 1900's. Your guided tour, in the 16-acre gardens, will focus on the history of the buildings still in use today.



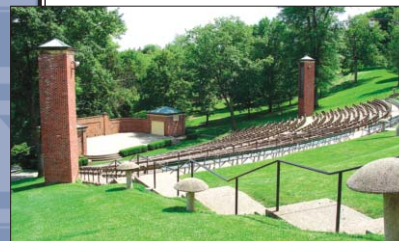

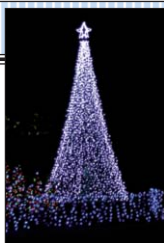
Festival of Lights Attractions include:
